We have over 15 years of electroplating experience in our PEKA workshop. Our skilled technicians specialise in high quality finishes on precious metal jewellery.

We deal with all parts of the New Zealand Jewellery trade and can plate small, one-off pieces to multiple units (large runs) of plating.

FAQs

What metals do you plate?

We plate all precious metals. We do not plate non-precious metals such as copper, brass or any base metal.

What plating finishes do you offer?

We offer the following plating finishes:

Yellow Gold

- Our gold plate is a hard gold plate of pure gold in 14ct yellow colour (up to two microns maximum).
- We recommend a 1 micron plate for low wear items such as earrings, pendants and lighter weight chain.
- We recommend a 2 micron plate for high wear items such as rings, bangles and bracelets.
- With heavy use of jewellery the plating will wear. Please bear this in mind when considering the item's design and its use.
- The maximum size of a product we can plate is approximately 65mm.

Rhodium

- We offer a rhodium plating service for rings only.

How much does it cost?

- Gold plating pricing is based on surface area.

How should I prepare my jewellery for plating?

- All jewellery must be supplied in a clean and highly polished state for the plating process to be successful. There will be a labour charge if this is not the case.
- If your product requires masking, please use nail polish. If you require PEKA to mask the item, please note we will charge labour for this service.
- If sending multiple items, please clearly identify them.
